Scene 12

An alarm clock changes to 6:30am, but before it goes off a hand reaches into the picture, slamming down on top of it to turn it off. Camera pans above Joshua, with hands over his eyes. He lets out a groan before climbing out of bed.

Joshua, with his backpack, comes downstairs once again and into the kitchen. His mom is gathering her things at the kitchen table, dressed in a business suit. His dad is making

breakfast in the kitchen as a small boy and girl (younger siblings) are sitting at the counter waiting excitedly. He gives them an "Are you serious?" look.

Dad: Order up! *Grinning, he sets three plates and forks in front of the kids and begins serving them eggs, bacon, and pancakes.* Now eat up, you guys need brain power because today is...

Scene 14

Joshua is sitting in a classroom, in a desk. He is looking around him, seeing people he hasn't met before talking and laughing with others. Suddenly, a girl walks in with glasses on. Joshua noticeably perks up at the sight of her. They catch eyes, and she smiles and walks over.

Girl: There you are, I began to wonder if we even had a class together! *Sitting in a desk beside him.*

Joshua: Really? *May looks taken aback.*

Voice: Now how about that, my two favorite people sitting beside each other! *The girl and Joshua both turn around to the voice.*

Girl: Newt!

Joshua: This isn't funny anymore guys.

Newt: What's wrong with you?

Joshua: Stop pretending this is our first day of high school over and over again!

Newt: Dude, chill, I'm not playing?

May: What on earth are you talking about Joshua?

Joshua: MOM! *His voice is also much deeper.* DAD! SOMEONE! *He runs into the kitchen. He stops in his tracks because he doesn't see anyone. Turning around, he runs back upstairs.* MOM! MOM? DAD???? *His parents bedroom door opens, and his mom stands there, rubbing one of her eyes.*

Mom: Joshua? Honey, are you okay? *Yawn.*

Joshua: Mom, what day is it?
